§ 1

Scope of validity

(1) This Supplement to the Measure sets out the amount of certain types of scholarships at the FIR in the academic year 2025/2026. It applies to students of Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes at the FIR. Scholarships may be awarded under the conditions set out in the Measure.

Exceptional scholarship for students on exchange outside the EU (overseas) and on work internship and traineeship outside the EU (overseas)

Internship or traineeship abroad	Study average in the previous academic year less than or equal to 1.50 and a minimum of 40 credits.	17,000 CZK per month
Internship or traineeship abroad	Study average in the previous academic year above 1.50	13 000 CZK per month
Exchange semester	Study average in the previous academic year below or equal to 1.50 and at least 40 credits.	One-time contribution 17 000 CZK
Exchange semester	Study average in the previous academic year above 1.50	One-time contribution 13 000 CZK

§ 4

Exceptional scholarship for students who are involved in scientific research and teaching activities of the faculty (student research assistant)

(1) The maximum amount of the exceptional scholarship for students who are involved in the scientific research and teaching activities of the faculty (student research assistant) is CZK 3,000 for each month worked in the range of 20 hours. The specific amount of the scholarship per month worked is determined on the basis of a proposal by the Head of the department depending on the amount of available financial resources.
